Appropriation (Judiciary Services 2009) Act 2008

Being an Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Judiciary Services for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2009 and to appropriate the supplies granted for that year.

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. GRANT OF K46,640,000

Subject to authorization from the Minister, the Secretary for Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for the services of the Judiciary for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2009 the sum of K46,640,000.

2. APPROPRIATION.

Sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for all the services of the financial year ending 31 December 2009 are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending 31 December 2009.
