International linkages will provide advice to the Government of PNG on development effectiveness, while also increasing external understanding of PNG's unique situation and access to diverse views that can help PNG learn from international experiences.

PROJECT CAPACITY:

The National Research Institute has the capacity to carry out research and implement the project activities jointly with AusAID and other stakeholders.

PROJECT BENEFICIARIES:

The project will benefit PNG as a whole in light of the aid effectiveness and its contribution to economic and social development of the country.

PROJECT SUSTAINABILITY

The National Research Institute will sustain the project activities through its recurrent budget once the project is completed by the end of 2010.
